WHAT IS TRAVEL SOCCER?

Travel soccer is an opportunity for your child to play the game they love at a higher level of competition against children from other communities.

This is a competitive, developmental program that will require commitment and dedication from your young athlete.

WHY TRAVEL SOCCER?

Competition & Camaraderie

Competition brings out the best in players. It is important for players to compete against others who will challenge them to become better soccer players and athletes. The Wellsboro Indoor Travel Program will provide players with this opportunity.

Travel team players enjoy practicing, playing, and being with their teammates, both on and off the field. The children look forward to developing as soccer players, but also enjoy spending time together at games/tournaments.

MUST I ATTEND WELLSBORO S.D.?

No. The travel soccer program will look at eligible and interested players inside and outside the Wellsboro School District.



WHAT ARE THE COMMITMENTS?

TIME

The travel indoor season will run from January through the end of March. The team will practice two nights per week and will participate in a minimum of three tournaments. Tournaments will be 1-day tournaments. No lodging is necessary. Attendance is expected.

TRAVEL

The Indoor Travel Program will play in tournaments that are in a radius of 2.5 hours from the Wellsboro area. All practices will be held in the Wellsboro Area School District facilities.

COST

The current cost of registration is \$150 per player (January 1, 2025 – March 31, 2025) which includes registration, uniforms, and tournament fees. *Fee may decrease pending sponsorship availability.

LEVEL OF COMPETITION

While the level of play is higher in the travel division, the WAYS coaching staff strives to make this a fun, competitive, and educational experience for both the athletes and their parents.

ARE THERE AGE REQUIREMENTS?

The inaugural WAYS indoor travel team will play in **G4 tournaments** in primarily the state of New York. Any student in fourth, third, or second grade can attend the try-out. Proof of grade level is required.

ARE TEAMS GENDER SPECIFIC?

In the WAYS travel program, boys and girls will play on the same team. The team will be entered into tournaments where they may play against teams that are either co-ed or boy only.

ARE THERE TRYOUTS?

Yes. A try out will be held in November. Your child's skill set, athleticism, and coachability will be assessed by a selection committee who have playing and/or coaching experience.

18-20 players will be offered a spot on the travel, indoor team.

If a player is offered a spot on the travel team, they have 48 hours to accept or decline the spot. Payment for those players who accept spots must be received by December 1, 2024.

IF MY CHILD MAKES THE TEAM THIS YEAR, ARE THEY GUARENTEED A SPOT NEXT YEAR?

No. We recognize children develop at different rates and to maintain the competitiveness of the program your child will try out every year for a spot on the indoor team.
